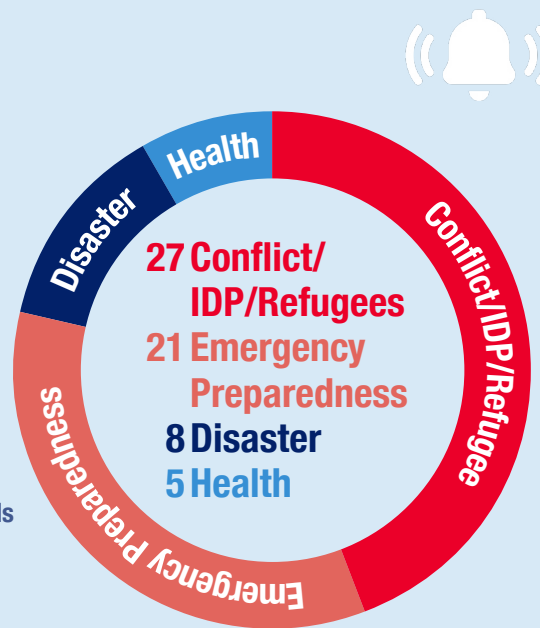
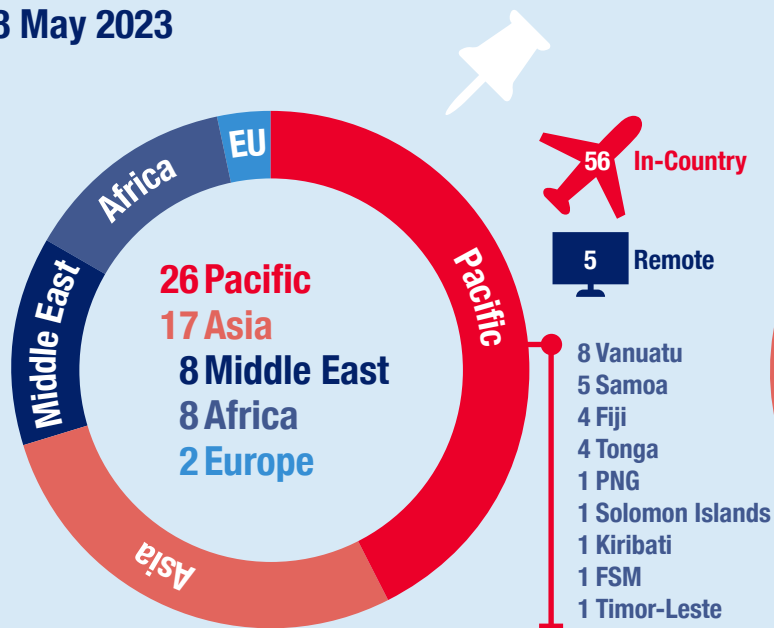


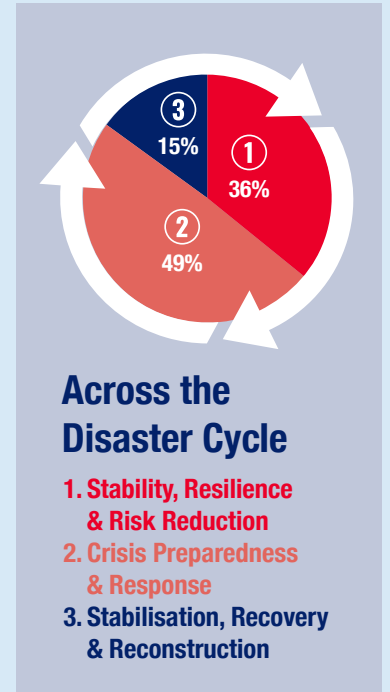
Australia Assists Deployments

Türkiye/Syria Earthquake Response

Working remotely from **Jordan**, WASH Coordinator **Tim**'s deployment with UNICEF pivoted in response to the February 6th earthquake which afflicted Türkiye and Syria, exacerbating pre-existing cholera caseloads in the region. Tim has worked to ensure service continuity through the early stages of the disaster response and helped affected communities receive a cholera-response with fewer supply gaps.



Vanuatu Cyclone Response

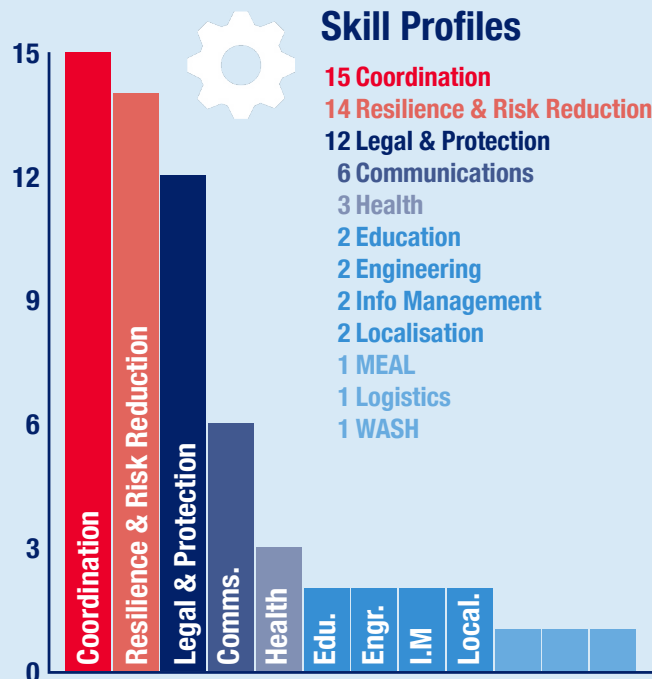
In **Vanuatu**, **Sharin** co-led the Emergency Medical Team Coordination Cell and its response to Tropical Cyclones Judy and Kevin. Supporting the Ministry of Health, Sharin and her team assessed medical needs and gaps on the ground in order to minimize many of the challenges faced during the national and international response to disaster.

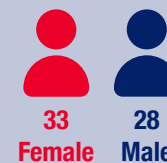


Localisation

In **Myanmar**, **Sonya** is working with FAO to support local NGO's and community-based organisations to take the lead in emergency responses. She met with one of FAO's local women-led civil society partners, Seine Lae Ayar, in Bogale, Ayeyarwady region to assess the learning needs of local partners.

Gender

In **Samoa**, **Warren** finalised a Family Violence Policy for Samoa Police, Prisons and Corrections Services. As part of the roll out of this policy, Warren conducted a 2-day training conference for Samoa Police on the Island of Savaii, where officers participated in information sessions and role plays designed to inform their response to gender-based violence.
