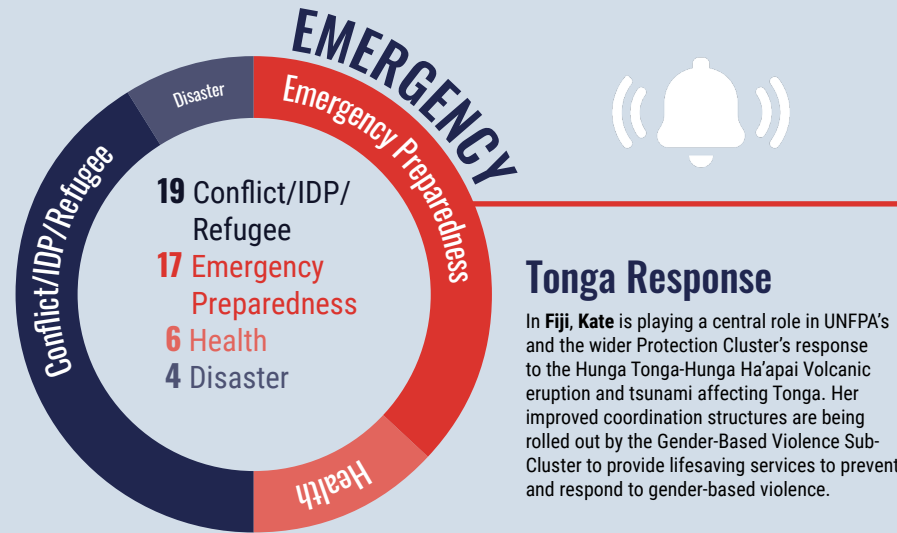
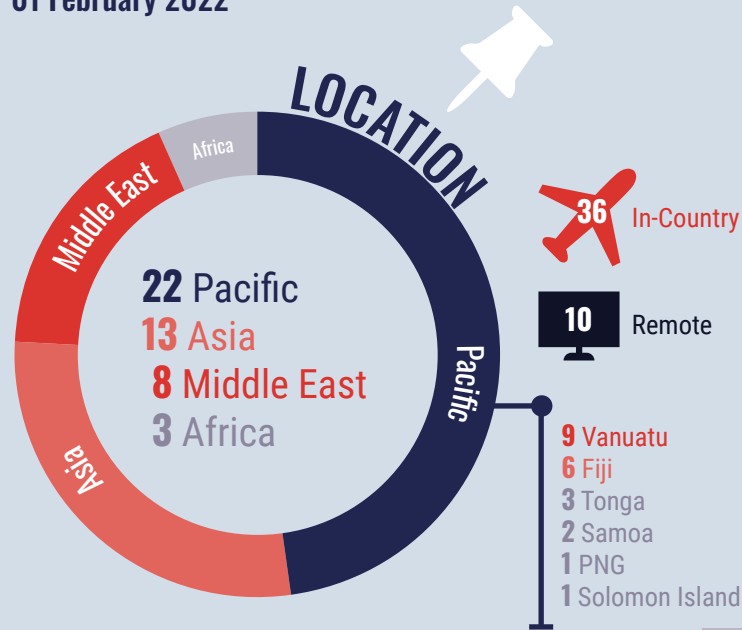


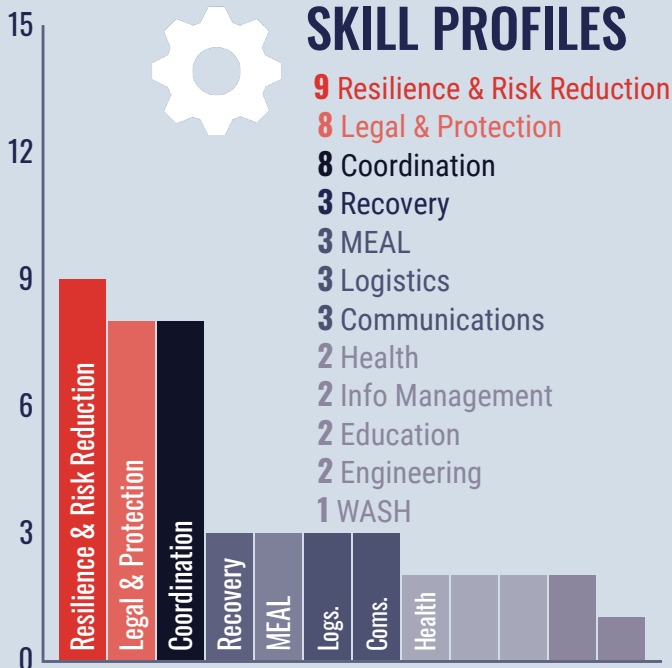
Australia Assists Deployments

Tonga Response

In Fiji, Kate is playing a central role in UNFPA's and the wider Protection Cluster's response to the Hunga Tonga-Hunga Ha'apai Volcanic eruption and tsunami affecting Tonga. Her improved coordination structures are being rolled out by the Gender-Based Violence Sub-Cluster to provide lifesaving services to prevent and respond to gender-based violence.



Disability

In Cox's Bazar in Bangladesh, Marguerite is supporting UNFPA's efforts to integrate the voices and experiences of people with disabilities into program and service design, planning and delivery for improved inclusivity, accessibility and quality.

Localisation

As a Vanuatu national, Rowan's local knowledge is an asset to the Ministry of Health where he is undertaking an inventory assessment of 42 health centres across three provinces. He is also providing training and logistics support to the country's COVID-19 vaccine rollout, assisting the mobilisation of vaccination teams and with transport for communities to reach vaccination sites.

Gender

In Jordan, Cynthia is contributing to the revision of UNRWA's sexual exploitation, abuse and harassment policy, as well as the implementation of a community-based complaints and feedback mechanism to report allegations. Cynthia is ensuring the local community is part of the solution to this issue, with her work directly contributing to the Australia Assists Gender Action Plan priority of ending violence against women and girls.
